At Stillman St. our wine is made to be very versatile so it will easily pair with a diversity of culinary preparations and taste preferences. This Chardonnay has been hand crafted from two family owned vineyards in Alexander Valley and Mendocino. Our Chardonnay is very complex and offers enticing flavors such as Anjou pear, crisp apple, and citrus that are complemented by a refreshing minerality. A portion of our wine was fermented and aged in older Oak barrels giving the wine structure, body, and complexity while still allowing for the pure Chardonnay grape characteristics to shine through. Ageing the wine on the lees (yeast remaining after the fermentation) adds a rich texture and more complexity. Stillman St. Chardonnay turns simple moments into celebrations.
